Tests are offered at Utah Schools for the Deaf and the Blind 742 Harrison Blvd. Ogden, Utah.

Each testing weekend has twenty testing slots available. The registration deadline is 30 days prior to the testing date. The Assessment costs \$250. Slots fill up fast so send in your registration and payment early.

Available Stipend:

Utah Educational Interpreters are eligible for a \$100 stipend through Utah State Office of Education. To take advantage of this offer contact, Christine Timothy prior to registering for the test. Christine.Timothy@schools.utah.gov or 801-538-7576. Once awarded the stipend indicate on your registration that USOE will pay the \$100 stipend. Only make your registration payment \$150. Do not pay the full amount.

Passing Score of 4.0

An initial score of a 3.5 is recognized as passing in Utah, with the stipulation that interpreters must advance to a 4.0 within four years from the date of original certification.
