Interpreter Maintenance & Certification Renewal Requirements

Utah Novice	\$70.00	20 hours annually	4 years; annual maintenance required	Within 4-year validation period, advance to Utah Professional
EIPA	\$70.00	20 hours annually	4 years; annual maintenance required	Within 4-year validation period, advance score to 4.0
Cued I & II	--	--	1 year; retesting required	1 year
Cued III	\$70.00	20 hours annually	2 years, retesting required; annual maintenance required	2 years
Cued IV	\$70.00	20 hours annually	4 years, retesting required; annual maintenance required	4 years
Professional, Master, Cued IV	\$70.00	60 hrs in 3 years	Renewable every 3 years; annual maintenance required	None

NOTE: It is your responsibility to read and understand the Interpreter Certification Renewal policy. If the policy is unclear to you, or if you have additional questions, please contact our office. Claiming you were not informed will not be an acceptable excuse! The policy will be strictly enforced.

Violation of the laws – such as interpreting above your certification skill level, Code of Ethics violations, etc.– may result in a Class B Misdemeanor (up to a \$1850 fine and six months in jail) and loss of your certification.
